out the rest – in feet or metres!

The company offers a range of polythene: There's a Thermal Anti Fog film that has special filters that dramatically

reduce many fungal diseases and condensation. This ingenious film contains an infra-red additive designed to reduce the speed with which heat escapes through the cover – ideal for propagating plants and raising tender bedding.

Then there's Super Clear, suited to areas of the UK where low light levels are common. It allows 95 per cent light transmission, scattering light that enters the tunnel.

All films sold by First Tunnels have a five-year guarantee against defects and can be cut to fit your polytunnel with no

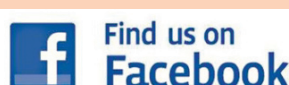
